Poor grade of < 0.7	2%	7%	8%	Online students show a 5% higher rate of receiving poor grades than F2F counterparts.
Low grade of < 2.0	5%	7%	10%	Online students show a 2% higher rate of receiving low grades than F2F counterparts.
Passing grade of > or = 2.0 or P (pass) grade	70%	70%	71%	Passing rates for online students are the exact same as F2F students.
W (official withdrawal), V (unofficial withdrawal), I (incomplete), Z (hardship withdrawal) grades	7%	11%	8%	Online students show a 4% higher rate of receiving W, V, I, or Z grades.
Other grades: H (hold), *	16%	5%	3%	Online students show a 11% lower rate of receiving other grades such as H.
