## It's simple!

- 1. Apply for admission to Shoreline Community College. Indicate your interest in receiving conditional guaranteed admission to IUPUI on your Shoreline application.
- 2. Receive an admission letter from Shoreline Community College, as well as a conditional guaranteed admission letter to IUPUI AT THE SAME TIME!
- 3. Take your admission letters, along with your I-20 document, to the U.S. embassy or consulate and apply for your F-1 visa.
- 4. Enroll at Shoreline and finish the first half of your Bachelor's degree by earning an A.A. or A.S. degree.
- 5. Transfer to IUPUI to finish the second half of your Bachelor's degree.
- 6. Complete your Bachelor's degree from IUPUI!

## Conditional Guaranteed Transfer Admission to IUPUI Requires:

- ✓ Completion of a Shoreline Community College transfer degree (Associate of Arts or Associate of Science).
- ✓ Evidence of English proficiency: completion of Shoreline Community College's English 101 with a grade of C or higher, iBT TOEFL 60, or IELTS 5.5.
- ✓ Shoreline Community College minimum cumulative GPA of 2.0.
- Submission of a completed application along with all supporting documents by the application deadline (May 1 for fall semester; December 1 for spring semester): <u>http://international.iupui.edu/admissions/how-apply/transfer/index.html</u>

Please note that the above requirements satisfy general requirements for transfer admission to IUPUI. Admission into competitive IUPUI programs is not guaranteed and depends on specific program admission requirements. Applicants who do not meet specific major requirements are guaranteed admission to IUPUI's University College.
